- We will responsibly store, manage and dispose of any substances of potential hazard to the environment.
- We will facilitate the recovery and recycling of silver and aluminium from our plate processing system.
- We are committed to equipping every employee with a sound understanding and awareness of environmental issues affecting and impacting their working environment.
- We will ensure company vehicles are fuel efficient and are serviced and maintained regularly to minimise their impact on the environment.
